

Jean-François Boileau, MD, MSc, FRCSC

Dr Boileau is an associate professor in the Departments of Surgery and Gerald Bronfman Oncology at McGill University. He is a surgical oncologist and clinician scientist at the Montreal Jewish General Segal Cancer Centre. He held previous positions at the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire de Montreal (CHUM) and at the Sunnybrook Odette Cancer Centre (University of Toronto).

He is currently the head of the Jewish General Hospital Breast Clinical Trials Group and a founding member of the Quebec McPeak-Sirois Clinical Trials Consortium. He is an author on the neoadjuvant breast PALLET (CDK 4/6) & KRISTINE (T-DM1) papers published in the Journal of Clinical Oncology & Lancet Oncology.

Dr Boileau is the Principle Investigator of the SN FNAC study (Journal of Clinical Oncology) that has helped to establish sentinel node biopsy as an acceptable method to re-stage the axilla of node positive breast cancer patients after neoadjuvant therapy.

As an early adopter of immediate pre-pectoral reconstruction, he has also developed a recognized expertise in skin and nipple sparing anatomical mastectomy.
