Biography

Dr Sharon Chan is the Clinical Director of Kowloon East Cluster Breast Centre, and Consultant of Department of Surgery at United Christian Hospital, Hong Kong. Dr. Chan is also the Honorary Associate Professor in Department of Surgery, The University of Hong Kong and The Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Dr Chan graduated from University of Hong Kong and received breast surgery training in Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Centre in New York and MD Anderson Cancer Centre in Texas. In 2008, she set up the first government funded breast centre in Hong Kong, which is now highly reputable in Hong Kong. Dr. Chan involves actively in clinical research. She was also involved in peer review in international journals. In 2009, she was awarded the Best Paper Prize by Breast Surgery International for her work in oncoplastic breast conserving surgery. Dr. Chan lectures internationally and widely, she was the program chairlady of World Congress of Surgery 2019.

Dr. Chan also contributed to breast surgery development internationally and locally. She is the Honorary Secretary of Breast Surgery International and the founding secretary of Hong Kong Society of Breast Surgeons. She organized cadaveric course, oncoplastic courses and USG courses both in overseas and in Hong Kong. Dr. Chan is also the founding steering committee of the Hong Kong Breast Cancer Registry and the Honorary Medical Advisor of Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation.
